

Initial Setup

Updated 17 June 2015

- Invite staff members and volunteers to the Filmroom Roster and make sure they join before gameday
- Add all of your Games and Opponents to Filmroom before the season starts to save time on gamedays
- Assign one staff member or volunteer to be your Filmroom lead so they can help other team members to set up their devices and gameday network connections

How will you record video?

Phone or Tablet

Video Camera

- OPTIONAL -Purchase a tripod, mount and lens kit
- Install the Filmroom mobile app for iOS or Android on your Recording Device
- Choose someone dependable to handle recording, and emphasize the importance of stopping the recording between plays

Record on your video camera and import one MP4 video file for each play to Filmroom after the game. Make sure to start & stop recording between plays.

- OPTIONAL -Choose someone to enter live stats on a mobile device or computer
- Install the Filmroom mobile app for iOS or Android on your Playback Device(s)

You can record offline, but Sideline Video and Live Stats require an Internet connection. Plays recorded in the Filmroom app will be automatically uploaded once you're back online.

System Check

- Record a few videos during warm ups to confirm your devices and/or network are working properly
